  - a. Finance Report
    - i. Preview of FY18 BUDGET Funding Street Outreach, Reducing City Direct Expenses in FY 18
      - 1. Running slightly over budget, 70% of Fiscal year, 75% of budget
      - 2. Discussion about snow removal costs. Thank you from Commission to Jim Daly, Maintenance Director, regarding the speedy snow removal.
      - 3. Presentation from Ron Redmond on CSM Fund Balance History
        - a. Indirect fees charged to CSM 6% of the budget. Has increased significantly this year.
        - b. Unclear what services CSM is receiving from the City in "general government" and "information services" General taxes should be paying for these services – not CSM budget. Request for explanation on these fees. City currently pays \$11k to CSM for snow removal.
      - 4. Street Outreach Funding
        - a. Presentation from Ron regarding current Target Funding Blend and Workforce Blend. Ron proposed to increase from \$7,500 to \$20,000 to help fund Street Outreach. Calls for service of those team members dedicated to the downtown shows 51% of Downtown calls occur on the Marketplace. Concerns from Commissioners regarding increasing CSM funding of Street Outreach. Commission consensus: If CSM increases funding for Street Outreach, CSM should be charged less for City Services.

- c. Marketplace Public Parking Garage Update
